Rapid antigen tests and RT_PCR test are no longer recognised as sufficient proof to enable free access to majority of services.

Only holders of valid vaccination certificates or valid certificate of recovery are considered as low-risk group.

Following services and places are accessible only for low-risk groups (holders of valid vaccination or recovery certificates):

- Restaurants
- Accommodation (hotels, B&B , Airbnb, etc.)
- Hairdressers, cosmetics, pedicure / manicure etc.
- Swimming pools
- Indoor sporting, fitness etc.
- Organised public events

Following groups have the exception and can use valid RT-PCR test to access the above-mentioned services. These groups (if insured in the CZ) have access to free RT-PCR test 5 times a month:

- Youngsters 12-18 years
- Persons with indicated contraindications to all covid-19 vaccines that has been properly marked in their health records (Czech Information system on communicable diseases)
- Persons that have received at least one dose are still not holders of a valid vaccination certificate (14 days after the second dose)

Warning: Pay attention especially to the rules that apply on accommodation in the Czech Republic. Only holders of valid vaccination certificate or valid certificate of recovery will be allowed to accommodate themselves in public places. This does not apply to business travellers or persons who were already accommodated before 22nd November 2021, but only for the period that was agreed upon the arrival.

Valid vaccination certificate:

- EU COVID Digital certificate
- Third-country certificates that were recognized as equivalent to the EU COVID digital certificate
- Recognized certificates from other countries

Valid certificate of recovery:

EU COVID Digital Certificate, no longer than 180 days after positive RT-PRC test.
