3. RECOMMENDATION FROM THE MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC FOR BRITISH CITIZENS IN CONNECTION WITH BREXIT

In a view of the planned withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (the UK) from the European Union at 31st October 2019, the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic reminds its earlier recommendations and, for reasons of legal certainty, time-saving and avoidance of possible more complicated administrative procedures in the future, **calls on UK citizens living in the Czech Republic to**:

- apply for a Certificate of Temporary Residence if they intend to stay in the country for more than three months (for further information visit https://www.mvcr.cz/mvcren/article/eu-citizens-and-their-familymembers.aspx)
